

Formation of Grievance Redressal Committee as per the AICTE Notification

The Committee, which is governed by its Constitution and is of perpetual succession, comprises elected representatives (Male and Female) from each of the five classes in the University and thereafter the office-bearers are elected by the members of the Committee. While the basic mandate of the Committee is to liaise between the student community, the faculty, administration and alumni, addressing grievances and conveying recommendations, the Committee in addition, aims to develop community life in the college to ensure holistic growth, an inclusive atmosphere and general welfare of the students. Amongst its various roles, it envisages engagement and overseeing of the various committees of the University, to be a prominent one, so as to ensure mediation of any conflicts and remove duplication of activities.

Procedure

To give in writing the complaint of any grievance reported by the women staff or student to the chairman of the committee. Regular meetings to be conducted to decide the further proceedings or steps to be taken accordingly.
